1) a copy of the identification page and the front cover of your passport, or photo driving licence for identification purposes, 2) a copy of your qualification certificate and references on headed notepaper from (i) an accountant or employer and (ii) a veterinary surgeon or clients to support at least four years regular and gainful working experience.
- **AFA CJF applicants:** Applicants holding the CJF must submit;

1) a copy of the identification page and the front cover of your passport, or photo driving licence for identification purposes, 2) a copy of your qualification certificate and 3) documentary evidence that you have been regularly and gainfully engaged in farriery for a period of two years subsequent to obtaining the qualification. This must be in the form of original statements from (i) a veterinary surgeon and (ii) an accountant or employer if employed.

I accept that entry to the Register of Farriers provides the entitlement to legally practice farriery within GB, it is not an alternative to securing a visa or meeting the UK Immigration Regulations required for residency or to work within the UK.
